




Since 2002, the Province of Manitoba has led a provincial elder abuse strategy focused on elder abuse prevention. Results below highlight work from April 1, 2022 – March 31, 2023.




330 calls were made to the seniors abuse support line



313 elder Clients received elder abuse counselling services from A&O



3 new clients were placed in Safe Suite accommodations through A&O: Support Services for Older Adults.
